## Call to Order:

1. FTEA Board President Morrie Rice called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm
2. Quorum was established

## Board Meeting Minutes Approved:

1. April Minutes: April 14, 2015 minutes were unanimously approved (Bleidistel/Ryerson)
2. May Minutes: Due to lack of quorum, there were no minutes from the May board meeting

## President's Report:

1. Resignation: Marcy Good resigned from the Board
2. Board Candidates Discussion and Election: Laurie Nelson (Ryerson/Bleidistel) and Jim Tuliglowski (Rice/Schreiner) were elected to the Board
3. Board Insurance---D\&O Liability: Deferred until next meeting
4. Walk a Thon Prizes: Continued discussion on prizes-For the $\$ 25-\$ 99$ donation level a $\$ 5$ Yogurtland gift certificate will be given, for the $\$ 100-\$ 249$ donation level ( 32 walkers), hats will be given. For the $\$ 250-\$ 499$ donation level (7 walkers) there
was a motion to give $\$ 25$ FYE gift card. This motion was unanimously approved (Schreiner/Ryerson). For the top 2 or 3 prize level, a gift selection list is to be created and presented to these two walkers. The gift selection list will be discussed at the next meeting.

## Vice President's Report:

1. Rotary Beer and Wine Festival Recap: Kerry reported 750 tickets were sold and the Festival was a great success. The financial success of this festival has led the three (3) Rotaries into discussions over what to do with the larger amount of money this successful festival reaped. The Rotaries may choose to increase their donation to FTEA and the other two (2) beneficiary groups originally selected or they may choose to increase the number of organizations they donate to. The Rotaries decision will be made known in upcoming months.
2. Enterprise Car Rental: FTEA has an account to rent vehicles with Enterprise

## Clubs: Kiwanis and South Bay Junior Women's Club:

1. Kiwanis Club: Carol read a Kiwanis letter to the Board.
2. So Bay Jr Women's Club: The club "adopted" nine (9) Walk-a-Thon athletes and made a donation in their names of $\$ 900$. The Club also made a generous $\$ 2,100$ donation to FTEA. Carol attended the Women's Club meeting and accepted these checks. It was suggested FTEA invite the Women's Club president to our September picnic.

## Budget Requests:

2. There was a discussion about spending some of the FTEA monies raised on (1) transportation to Meets, (2) re-instating the year-end Pizza party, (3) Warm-ups for swimmers and (4) Liability insurance for FTEA directors and officers
